It is set in the future and everyone has reached equality.

"Some things about living still weren't quite right." (2)

Things have gone awry - although they have achieved equality, some things still not right.

CUSTOMS OF TIME

"... 211<sup>th</sup>, 212<sup>th</sup> and 213<sup>th</sup> Amendments"

Change is rapid - there are a lot of rules and amendments (today we have 26)

"H-G men took George and Hazel Bergeron's fourteen-year-old son, Harrison, away" (1)
